### Leading Off

Reds CF Drew Stubbs homered to lead off yesterday's day/night doubleheader, then homered again in the eighth inning of the nightcap...he is the first leadoff batter to homer in 2 games on the same day since Chi's Alfonso Soriano did it against the Cardinals on 9/15/07...the last leadoff batter to do it for the Redlegs was Kal Daniels on 4/19/87 vs Hou...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is **Game 3** (2-0) of a 4-game series vs **Danny Hart's** Pirates and **Game 6** (3-2) of a 7-game homestand that included a 3-game set over the weekend with the **Dodgers** (1-2)...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 15g at **Great American Ball Park** and 16g on the road...on Friday the Reds begin a 10-game road trip to **Atl** (3g), **Col** (4g) and **Chi** (3g)...also beginning Friday the Reds will play 17 consecutive days, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3g at Atl, 4g at Col, 3g at Chi, 3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla).

**BLUE JACKET:** Columbus Blue Jackets defenseman **Mike Commodore** will participate in Reds batting practice this afternoon and then will sign autographs from 5:40 to 6:40 at the Reds Community Fund booth behind Section 120 before throwing out the ceremonial first pitch.

**DOT. DOT. DOT:** With yesterday's 4-3 and 6-3 victories, the Reds swept a doubleheader for the first time since they beat the Rockies on **8/25/97 at Coors Field** (7-6, 6-4), swept a DH at home for the first time since **5/26/97 vs Phi** (8-5, 8-4) and swept the Pirates for the first time since **7/9/76 at Riverfront Stadium** (12-11, 2-1)...the Redlegs are **7-2 in their last 9g**...in their last 14g have played **5 extra-inning affairs**...at **49-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **109 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues and have been outscored in the opening frame, **109-66**...allowed first-inning runs in 53 of their 131g this season.

**REDS HALL OF FAME:** Through tomorrow, Reds fans can vote for the **Reds Hall of Fame Class of 2010** online at [reds.com/HOF](http://reds.com/HOF) or via paper ballot that can be found at the **Hall of Fame and Museum**, the **Reds Community Corner** at **Section 120** in Great American Ball Park or at participating **Skyline Chili** and **Montgomery Inn** locations...the candidates include **Bret Boone**, **Jeff Brantley**, **Norm Charlton**, **John Franco**, **Danny Graves**, **Kevin Mitchell**, **Hal Morris**, **Paul O'Neill**, **Chris Sabo** and **Scott Sullivan**.

**HAL MCCOY:** Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on **Wed, 9/16**...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 49 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **108 different lineups** in 131g.

**SURGERIES:** Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** Six Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum** and **OF Drew Stubbs**...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**EMMY AWARD:** For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piccoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfors**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (29-37 .439):** The Reds are 3-2 on this homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 2-0 vs Pit)...went **5-13-3 in their previous 21 home series**...produced a winning record on just 2 of their 10 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **270-282-1**...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (29-36, .446):** The Reds' current 4-game road winning streak ties their longest of the season (5/5-5/13)...went 4-2 on their most recent road trip (1-2 at Pit, 3-0 at Mil)...went **9-10-2 in their 21 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (**7-3**, **3-2**, **3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3**, **4-2**)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the **Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (148):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 55, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...yesterday were a season-high **19.5 games out of first place**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **69** days below .500.

**REDS vs PIRATES:** The Reds are **974-1,020 all-time** vs the Pirates, including 6-4 this season...at **Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 28-29 all-time, including 3-1 this season..**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 6/10-6/11, 1997 (2g); 9/25-9/27, 1998 (3g); 8/14-8/17, 1975 (4g).

IF Paul Janish pitched in the ninth inning of the 15-3 loss vs Mil on 5/6 (1ip, 5h, 5er, 0bb, 2k, Fielder 2-run HR) and in the eighth inning of the historic 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi (1ip, 4h, 6er, 2bb, 1k, Werth grand slam)...he became the first Reds position player to pitch since Lenny Harris on 6/1/98 at SF and the first Reds position player to pitch more than once in a season since OF Mel Queen took the mound 7 times during the second half of the 1966 campaign.				

**Reds Pitchers:** Rank 10th in the National League with a 4.38 staff ERA...on the homestand are **3-2, 4.13 (48ip, 22er)**...in the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 22 runs in a game for the first time since a 22-6 loss at Chi on **8/13/37**...the Reds already have 11 team shutouts, their highest total since they had 11sho in 1999...haven't had more than 11 shutouts since 1990, when they threw 12...had 6 shutouts all of last year.

**Reds Starters:** Rank 12th in the National League with a 4.74 rotation ERA...on the homestand are **2-1, 2.78 (32.1ip, 10er)**...have produced 62 quality starts (**Arroyo 17, Harang 14, Cueto 12, Owings 6, Bailey 5, Volquez 3, Lehr 3, Maloney 1, Wells 1**)...the Reds went 43-19 in those quality starts (.694)...from **6/3-6/10** produced a season-high **7 consecutive quality starts**, their best stretch since they threw 8 consecutive QS from **8/6-8/14, 2005**...through the first 41g of the season used just 5 starting pitchers, their longest such streak to begin a year since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994 campaign**...on 5/23 vs Cle, in the club's 42nd game, **RHP Homer Bailey** became the Reds' sixth starting pitcher...**Aaron Harang** threw a 3-hitter in the 2-0 win vs Pit in the club's fifth game of the season...was the earliest complete game by a Reds pitcher since **Pete Harnisch** beat the Cardinals, 3-0 in Busch Stadium, in the **fourth** contest of the **1999** campaign.

**Reds Relievers:** Rank fourth in the National League with a 3.71 bullpen ERA...on the homestand are **1-1, 6.89 (15.2ip, 12er)**...in 7.1 innings during the 22-1 loss on 7/6 at Phi allowed 13r/12er, the bullpen's highest single-game totals since identical totals in a 16-3 loss on **6/1/98 at SF**...bullpen's ERA excluding that game drops from 3.71 to 3.51 (400.1ip, 156er)...didn't blow a save until the club's 36th game, a 6-5 loss in 16 innings on 5/16 at SD...for the second straight season the Reds' bullpen was the last in the Major Leagues to suffer a blown save...in 2008 didn't blow a save until the 41st game (5/14)...over the last 2 seasons **Cordero** has recorded **63** of the bullpen's **64** saves (34sv in 2008, 29sv in 2009)...**David Weathers** has the club's only other save over the last 2 seasons (6/10/09 at Wsh).

51 JARED BURTON, rhp41g, 0-0-0, 5.10													
Has posted a 3.18era in 10 apps since he was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list (11.1ip, 4er)...from 7/26-8/9 was on the DL with right shoulder fatigue...made rehab apps for Dayton (1g, 1ip, 1h, 0r, 0bb, 3k) and Louisville (2g, 1-0, 2ip, 0h, 0bb, 2k)...began the season with Cin and posted a 6.33era in 20 apps before he was optioned to Louisville on 6/1, when Edinson Volquez came off the disabled list...never left the team and was recalled the next day, when Volquez returned to the disabled list...posted a 2.19era in 9 more apps for the Reds before he was optioned to Louiiville on 7/1, when IF Drew Sutton was promoted...returned to Cin on 7/20 and made 2 more apps before he went on the disabled list with the right shoulder injury...overall made 10 apps for Louisville (3-0, 0.82, 11ip, 8h, 1er, 3bb, 10k).

**48 FRANCISCO CORDERO, rhp55g, 2-3-29, 2.32**  
Was an All-Star for the third time (2004 for Tex, 2007 for Mil)...from 8/25-8/28 pitched 4 straight days for the first time since 7/3-7/6, 2008...from 8/23-8/28 pitched in 5 straight games for the first time since he threw in a career-high 6 straight Brewers games from 5/4-5/9, 2007...with 29 saves ranks T5th in the National League...converted 29 of his 31 save opps...including last season has recorded 63 of the bullpen's last 64 saves (34sv in 2008, 29sv in 2009, Weathers 1sv in 2009)...with 240 career saves ranks 29th on that all-time list...Dan Quisenberry is 28th with 244...in the 3-0 victory on 4/22 at Chi recorded his 100th save in the National League to become only the 11th pitcher in history with at least 100 saves in each league (see box).

Last name is pronounced MASS-it...has made a career-high 56 apps...pitched in both games of Mon's doubleheader...opponents are hitting just .197 (42-213), including .190 by RH batters (26-137)...from 4/28-6/14 produced a career-best 16.2-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest by a Reds pitcher this season (Arroyo 17ip)...from 5/19-5/25 was on the 15-day disabled list with a strained left oblique muscle...posted a 1.23era in 11 apps before his disabling (14.2ip, 2er) and a 3.13era in 45 apps since he came off the DL (46ip, 16er).
