## Central Casting

Heading into the upcoming weekend series at Chi's **Wrigley Field**, the Reds have won their last 8 games vs National League Central Division rivals (1-0 at Pit, 3-0 at Mil, 4-0 vs Pit).

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 4** (0-3) of a 4-game series vs **Matt Belisle's** Rockies and **Game 7** (3-3) of a 10-game road trip that included a weekend sweep at Atl's **Turner Field** (3-0) and entails a series at the friendly confines of Chi's **Wrigley Field** (3g) beginning tomorrow...today's game is **Game 7** (3-3) in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3-0 at Atl, **0-3 at Col**, 3g at Chi, 3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **Mon, 9/21**...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 13g at **Great American Ball Park** and 10g on the road.

**REHAB WATCH:** **OF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist) is on a rehabilitation assignment with Louisville (6g, .238, 5-21, 3bb, 3k, 2sb, 3r)...last night he went 0-3 with a walk and an outfield assist in the Bats' 8-4 loss at Durham in Game 1 of the International League playoffs (best-of-5 series)...**Bruce** has been eligible to come off the disabled list since 7/27.

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** **Dusty Baker** has **1,299 victories** as a Major League manager...the Rockies never have swept the Reds in a 4-game series...today's **20.0-game deficit** is the Reds' largest of the season...**1B Joey Votto** today is celebrating his 26th birthday...on Saturday, bullpen catcher **Mike Stefanski** turns 40...at **53-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **110 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues and have been outscored in the opening frame, **110-71**...allowed first-inning runs in 54 of their 139g this season.

**MICAH UPDATE:** RHP **Micah Owings** left Sun's 4-2 victory at Atl after he was hit in the helmet by a **Kenshin Kawakami** pitch with the bases loaded in the top of the 12th inning...he did not have symptoms of a concussion but suffered a perforation to his left ear drum and a cut to his face that required 5 stitches...a CT scan was normal...**Owings** is expected to fly to Chicago today and work out with the team on tomorrow, when his playing status will be updated...the HBP forced in the run that snapped the 2-2 tie and made **Owings** the winning pitcher.

**HAL McCOY:** Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on **Wednesday**...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **115 different lineups** in 139g.

**SURGERIES:** **Seven** Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

**MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS:** **Seven** Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum, OF Drew Stubbs** and **LHP Pedro Viola**...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/ IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (31-37 .456):** The Reds' current 4-game home winning streak ties their season high (5/24-5/27)...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 4-0 vs Pit), including their first 4-game home sweep of the **Pirates** since **August 1975**...went **6-13-3 in their 22 home series**...produced a winning record on 3 of their 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **272-282-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (32-39, .451):** The Reds are **3-3** on this road trip (3-0 at Atl, **0-3 at Col**, 3g at Chi)...including this one have gone **10-11-2 in their 23 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3, 4-2**)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (157):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 64, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...on **9/9** were a season-high **20.5g out of first place**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **78** days below .500.

**REDS vs ROCKIES:** The Reds are 71-70 all-time vs the Rockies, including 0-6 this season and 1-5 in 2008...since 6/2/07 have lost 13 of their last 14g vs Col, including each of the last 8g...the Reds and Rockies are playing a 4-game series for the first time since **7/13-7/16, 2006** at Cin (4-0 Reds sweep) and are playing a 4-game series at Coors Field for the first time since **4/10-4/13, 1998** (Reds won series, 3-1)...**at Coors Field:** Reds are 25-35, including 0-3 this season and 1-2 in 2008...the Reds were involved in 3 of the highest scoring games in Coors Field history (24-12 win on 5/19/99, 18-7 wins on 4/10/98 & 8/29/96)...went 3-7 at Mile High Stadium...**last Rockies sweep:** at Cin: 7/31-8/2, 2009 (3g)...at Col: 7/23, 1998 (2g, day/night DH); 6/3-6/5, 2005 (3g).

**UP NEXT: REDS at CUBS:** The Reds are 1,051-1,083 all-time vs the Cubs, including 983-1,012 since 1900 and 4-8 this season...against the Cubs in September/October, the Reds are 21-19 over the last 7 seasons and 35-33 over the last 12 years...**at Wrigley Field:** Reds are 402-431 all-time, including 2-4 this season.

**Last Pitched:** Sat at Atl and allowed just 1 hit in 6.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-1 victory (4bb, 4k, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 51 strikes)...left leading, 3-0.... was his first victory since 4/17/08 for Col at SD, snapping a 6-game losing streak...allowed only Anderson's single leading off the second inning... stranded 6 baserunners.

**Red Hots:** Media guide bio is in the press box...is making his seventh appearance and fourth start for the Reds...his appearance on 8/26 at Mil was his first Major League start since 7/21/08, snapping a string of 66 consecutive relief apps for the Rockies, Royals, Nationals and Reds...in his 3 starts the Reds went 3-0 and scored 11 runs (3.67 r/g).

**2009 Season:** Was signed by the Nationals during spring training...began the season at Class AAA Syracuse and was promoted on 4/20 after posting a 2.45era in 2 starts...from 5/31-6/14 was on Wsh's disabled list with a strained right shoulder...was released on 7/6 and the next day was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract...was assigned to Class AAA Louisville and posted a 3.07 in 1 start and 4 relief apps before he was promoted on 7/31, along with RHP Justin Lehr, when the Reds traded IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. to the Yankees and 3B Edwin Encarnacion and RHP Josh Roenicke to the Blue Jays...made his Reds debut on 8/10 at STL after Cueto left in the second inning with an injury.

**Wells' Most Recent Starts:** **8/26 at Mil**, in his first start since 7/21/08 received no decision in the 10-inning, 4-3 victory (5ip, 7h, 3er, 3bb, 2k, 2hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 55 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2, but the Reds tied it in the eighth inning and won it in the 10th...allowed all 3 runs on a pair of home runs in the fifth inning, a solo HR to Gerut with 1 out and a 2-out, 2-run HR to Fielder..**8/31 vs Pit**, in the opener of the day/night doubleheader was the victim of a blown save in the 4-3 victory (6ip, 2h, 2er, 4bb, 2k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 3-2, but the Bucs tied it with a run in the seventh inning off Fisher...allowed both runs in the second on RBI-singles to Jaramillo and McCutchen.

## Tomorrow at Cubs: RHP Justin Lehr

**Last Pitched:** On 9/1 vs Pit and earned the 11-5 victory (6ip, 6h, 4er, 5bb, 2k, 1hr, 114 pitches, 69 strikes)...left leading, 9-4... allowed 2 runs in the third inning, including a 2-run HR by Jones, and 2 more runs in the fourth...was bothered after that game by a sore right groin.

**Red Hots:** Last name is pronounced **LEER**...media guide bio is available in the press box...tomorrow at Cubs will make his eighth career start, all this season, but his first appearance since 9/1...was scheduled to start Mon at Col but was scratched with a sore right groin...in August led the staff in wins (3)...in his 7 starts the Reds went 4-3 and scored 37 runs (5.29 r/g)...has 3 quality apps in 6 starts and fell 3 outs shy of producing another...on **7/31 vs Col** made his first Major League appearance since **5/22/06 for Mil at Cin** and his first career big league start...on **8/5 vs Chi** earned his first career victory since **5/18/06 vs Phi** (5-4 Brewers win)...on **8/11 at StL** singled off **Mitchell Boggs** for his first Major League hit.

**Most Valuable Pitcher:** Was named the International League's **Most Valuable Pitcher**...at Leigh Valley (Phillies) and Louisville combined to finish **13-3, 3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...3 times was IL Pitcher of the week...was the starting pitcher for the IL in the **Triple-A All-Star Game** in Portland.

**Shutout:** In his 4-0 victory on **8/5 vs the Cubs** threw a complete-game shutout in just his second Major League start (4h, 1bb, 4k)... became the first Reds pitcher to throw a shutout in his first or second career start since **Charlie Leibrandt** beat the Braves, 5-0, in his big league debut on **4/13/80** and the first pitcher to do it for any team since the Red Sox' **Clay Buchholz** threw a no-hitter on 9/1/07 vs Bal in his second career start...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

**2009 Season:** In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 7/31 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by **RHP Micah Owings**, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went **13-3, 3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...3 times was International League Pitcher of the Week, including twice for Lehigh Valley in the first 5 weeks of the season and from **7/20-7/26** for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88)...was IL's starting pitcher in the **Triple-A All-Star Game** in Portland.
