TODAY'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Chuck Wasserstrom's** Cubs and **Game 9** (3-5) of a 10-game road trip that included a **3-0 sweep** at Atl's **Turner Field** (3-0) followed by an **0-4 visit** to Col's **Coors Field**...was the Reds' first sweep in Atlanta since **7/16-7/18, 2007** and their first ever 4-game sweep loss to the Rockies...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with **13g at Great American Ball Park** (3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit) and **8g on the road** (2g at Chi, 3g at Pit, 3g at Hou).

PLAYIN' EVERY DAY: Today's game is **Game 9** (3-5) in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, **0-1 at Chi**, 3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **Monday, 9/21**, when they will travel to Pittsburgh to begin their final road trip of the season.

REHAB WATCH: **OF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist) is on a rehabilitation assignment with Louisville (7g, .250, 6-25, 4bb, 5k, 2sb, 3r)...in last night's 4-3 Bats loss vs Durham in the first round of the International League playoffs he served as the designated hitter and went 1-4 with a walk and 2 strikeouts...Louisville trails in the best-of-5 series, 2-1.

DOT. DOT. DOT: Yesterday's 6-4 loss snapped the Reds' 8-game winning streak vs NL Central rivals (1-0 at Pit, 3-0 at Mil, 4-0 vs Pit), 1 win shy of the franchise record for consecutive victories within the division...**Dusty Baker** has **1,299 victories** as a Major League manager...bullpen catcher **Mike Stefanski** today is celebrating his 40th birthday...for the second straight day the Reds face a season-high **20.5-game deficit**...the Reds will be eliminated from National League Central Division contention with their next loss or the **Cardinals'** next win...at **53-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **110 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, **110-72**...allowed first-inning runs in 54 of their 141g this season.

STAFF EXPANSION: On Monday, Class AA Carolina manager **David Bell** will join **Dusty Baker's** coaching staff...on 9/22, Class AAA Louisville manager **Rick Sweet** will join the staff in relief of **Bell**.

HAL MCCOY: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony at Great American Ball Park on **Wednesday**...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **117 different lineups** in 141g.

SURGERIES: **Seven** Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: **Seven** Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum**, **OF Drew Stubbs** and **LHP Pedro Viola**...in **2008**, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Picoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfors**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (31-37 .456): The Reds' current 4-game home winning streak ties their season high (5/24-5/27)...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 4-0 vs Pit), including their first 4-game home sweep of the **Pirates** since **August 1975**...went **6-13-3 in their 22 home series**...produced a winning record on 3 of their 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **272-282-1**...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (32-41, .438): The Reds are **3-5** on this road trip (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, **0-1 at Chi**)...went **10-11-2 in their previous 23 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3, 4-2**)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (159): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 66, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...for the second straight day face a season-high **20.5-game deficit**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **80** days below .500.

REDS vs CUBS: The Reds are 1,051-1,084 all-time vs the Cubs, including 983-1,013 since 1900 and 4-9 this season...against the Cubs in September/October, the Reds are 21-20 over the last 8 seasons and 35-34 over the last 13 years...**at Wrigley Field:** Reds are 402-432 all-time, including 2-5 this season...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 4/25-4/26, 1994 (2g); 9/24-9/26, 2002 (3g); 4/8-4/11, 1983 (4g)...at Chi: 5/14-5/15, 1966 (2g); 8/8-8/10, 2005 (3g); 8/16-8/18, 1968 (4g)...**last Cubs sweep:** at Cin: 4/26-4/27, 1995 (2g); 5/28-5/30, 2001 (3g)...at Chi: 7/21-7/22, 2004 (2g); 7/24-7/26, 2009 (3g).

Last Pitched: Sun at Pit and received no decision in the 12-inning, 4-2 victory (6ip, 3h, 1er, 2bb, 9k, 2hbp, 107 pitches, 72 strikes)...left with the score tied, 1-1, but Ross homered on the first pitch by Burton in the bottom of the seventh...didn't allow a hit until LaRoche singled with 1 out in the fourth inning...in the fifth allowed a 2-out, RBI-double to Prado...as a batter, led off the third inning with a single and scored the game's first run.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 27th start of the season, his third since a stint on the disabled list with inflammation in his right shoulder...was on the DL from **8/20-8/31**...in 2 starts since then is **1-0, 1.64** (11ip, 2er)...leads the Major Leagues in hit batsmen (13, tied w/ Mil's Dave Bush) and 3 times hit 2 batters in a game...in his 26 starts the Reds went 13-13 and scored 100 runs (3.85 r/g)...in 9 of his 26 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 17 of his 26 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Streaking: The 6-3 win on 8/31 vs Pit snapped his career-high 6-game losing streak...through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...**in his next 8 starts, from 7/6-8/15, went 0-6, 10.64**...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25**...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau)...as 13 quality starts...put together 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Cueto vs Cubs: **4/22 at Chi**, in one of the best starts of his career threw 7.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-0 victory (4h, 0bb, 3k, 108 pitches, 68 strikes)...left leading, 1-0...the Reds added insurance runs in the eighth and ninth innings...**7/25 at Cubs** and suffered the 5-3 loss (6ip, 9h, 4er, 3bb, 4k, 2hr, 105 pitches, 62 strikes)...left trailing, 4-1...in the first inning allowed 3 runs on a walk and 5 hits, including an RBI-bloop triple to Lee and a 2-run HR to Ramirez...in the fifth allowed Soriano's solo HR...**8/4 vs Chi** and suffered the 6-3 loss (5.2ip, 7h, 5er, 2bb, 4k, 2hbp, 1hr, 103 pitches, 63 strikes)...left trailing, 4-0, but was charged with another run scored off Herrera...allowed Fukudome's first Major League leadoff HR... with 2 outs in the sixth inning allowed Hill's 2-run bloop double off the glove of the diving Taveras, followed by Gorzelanny's RBI-bloop single.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Homer Bailey

Last Pitched: Mon at Col and in his first career appearance at Coors Field was the victim of a blown save in the 4-3 loss (5.2ip, 5h, 1er, 5bb, 6k, 117 pitches, 71 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, but the Rockies tied it in the seventh inning with 2 runs off Rhodes...allowed his only run with 2 outs in the third inning on Helton's RBI-single.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 16th start of the season, the 33rd start of his Major League career and his first career appearance at **Wrigley Field**...in his last 4 starts is **3-0, 1.67** (27ip, 5er)...from 8/23-9/2 put together a career-high **11-inning scoreless streak**... in his 15 starts the Reds went 6-9 and scored 69 runs (4.60 r/g)... has 6 quality starts, including 3 of his last 4 apps...twice was the victim of blown saves.

2009 Season: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the Reds' 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Twice this season was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record.
