### Bonus Baseball

Six of the Reds' 22 games played on Sundays went into extra innings, including each of the last 2 Sunday games (both 12 innings)...this season the Red are 8-7 in extra-inning affairs and won 4 of their last 5 extra-inning games.

TODAY'S GAME: Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs Tim Hellmann's Cubs and Game 10 (4-5) of a 10-game road trip that included a 3-0 sweep at Atl's Turner Field (3-0) followed by an 0-4 visit to Col's Coors Field...was the Reds' first sweep in Atlanta since 7/16-7/18, 2007 and their first ever 4-game sweep loss to the Rockies...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with 13g at Great American Ball Park (3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit) and 7g on the road (1g at Chi, 3g at Pit, 3g at Hou).

<u>PLAYIN' EVERY DAY</u>: Today's game is **Game 10** (4-5) in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, **1-1 at Chi**, 3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **Monday**, **9/21**, when they will travel to Pittsburgh to begin their final road trip of the season.

**REHAB WATCH**: **OF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist) is on a rehabilitation assignment with Louisville (8g, .233, 7-30, 4bb, 6k, 2sb, 4r)...in last night's 10-7 Bats victory vs Durham in the first round of the International League playoffs he served as the designated hitter and went 1-for-5 with a run scored...the best-of-5 series is tied at 2-2.

**DOT, DOT:** Yesterday's 7-5 win was **Dusty Baker's 1,300th** as a Major League manager...for the third straight day the Reds face a season-high **20.5-game deficit**...the Reds will be eliminated from National League Central Division contention with their next loss or the **Cardinals'** next win...their elimination number in the **Wild Card** is **3**, not including the result of the Rockies' late game last night at SD...Reds baserunners have been successful on each of their last 5 stolen base attempts...at **53-0** the Reds club is the NL's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 110 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, 110-72...allowed first-inning runs in 54 of their 142g this season.

STAFF EXPANSION: Tomorrow, Class AA Carolina manager David Bell will join Dusty Baker's coaching staff...on 9/22, Class AAA Louisville manager Rick Sweet will join the staff in relief of Bell.

<u>HAL McCOY</u>: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony at Great American Ball Park on **Wednesday...McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **117 different lineups** in 142g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C** Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), **SS** Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron** Harang (appendectomy).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: Seven Reds players made their Major League debuts this season, including RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum, OF Drew Stubbs and LHP Pedro Viola..in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (31-37 .456): The Reds' current 4-game home winning streak ties their season high (5/24-5/27)...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 4-0 vs Pit), including their first 4-game home sweep of the Pirates since August 1975...went 6-13-3 in their 22 home series...produced a winning record on 3 of their 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, 5-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 272-282-1... from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008).

REDS ON THE ROAD (32-42, .432): The Reds are 4-5 on this road trip (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-1 at Chi)...went 10-11-2 in their previous 23 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3, 4-2)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (160): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 67, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 51-71 were a season-high 20g under .500...for the third straight day face a season-high 20.5-game deficit...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 81 days below .500.

<u>REDS vs CUBS</u>: The Reds are 1,052-1,084 all-time vs the Cubs, including 984-1,013 since 1900 and 5-9 this season... against the Cubs in September/October, the Reds are 22-20 over the last 8 seasons and 36-34 over the last 13 years... <u>at Wrigley Field</u>: Reds are 403-432 all-time, including 3-5 this season.

<u>UP NEXT: REDS vs ASTROS</u>: The Reds are 405-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 7-3 this season...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 19-32-1, including 4-2 this season...their 3-game sweep in May was Cin's first here since September 2000...the Reds' 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped their 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...**Lance Berkman's** 21 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Albert Pujols** 2nd, 15)...among opposing pitchers, **Roy Oswalt's** 7 victories there are second only to the 8 wins by Chi's **Carlos Zambrano**.

**Last Pitched**: Mon at Col and in his first career appearance at Coors Field was the victim of a blown save in the 4-3 loss (5.2ip, 5h, 1er, 5bb, 6k, 117 pitches, 71 strikes)...left leading, 3-1, but the Rockies tied it in the seventh inning with 2 runs off Rhodes...allowed his only run with 2 outs in the third inning on Helton's RBI-single.

Red Hots: Is making his 16th start of the season, the 33rd start of his Major League career and his first career appearance at Wrigley Field... in his last 4 starts is **3-0**, **1.67** (27ip, 5er)...from 8/23-9/2 put together a career-high **11-inning scoreless streak**...in his 15 starts the Reds went 6-9 and scored 69 runs (4.60 r/g)...has 6 quality starts, including 3 of his last 4 apps...twice was the victim of blown saves.

**2009 Season**: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle...in that 5/23 start vs the Indians became only the sixth different pitcher to start a game for the Reds this season, in the club's 42nd game...was the longest such streak to begin a season since **RHP John Roper** became the staff's **sixth** different starter in the **42nd game** of the **1994** campaign.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his most recent start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.

<u>IL Pitcher of the Week</u>: Twice this season was named the International League's **Pitcher of the Week**...in 2 starts the week of **4/20-4/26** went 2-0, 2.92 with 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings (10h, 6bb)...in the 10-3 win at Toledo on 4/26, over 6.1 innings he struck out a career-high 15 batters to tie the Louisville single-game record... in 2 starts from **6/1-6/7** went 2-0 without allowing a run (14.2ip, 11h, 2bb, 14k).

### **Tomorrow vs Astros: Bronson Arroyo**

Last Pitched: Wed at Col and received no decision in the dramatic 4-3 loss (7ip, 5h, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0, but the Reds tied it in the top of the eighth inning...in the third allowed a sac fly to Smith and a 2-out, RBI-single to Atkins...while he was in the game, Reds batters produced 1 hit off Rockies starter Jason Hammel...Col won it on Smith's 2-out, 2-run single in the bottom of the ninth inning.

Red Hots: Tomorrow vs Hou will make his 30th start of the season... posted a **1.99era** in August, a **2.42era** since the All-Star break and a **2.17era** in his last 12 starts (87ip, 21er)...pitched into the seventh inning in each of his last 9 starts...in his previous 29 starts the Reds went 13-16 and scored 108 runs (3.72 r/g).

Milestones: Will enter tomorrow night's game with 29 starts and 190.0 innings pitched...produced at least 30 starts and 200 innings in each of the previous 4 seasons...is looking to become 1 of only a handful of pitchers to record at least 200 innings in each of the last 5 seasons...Dan Haren already reached the plateau (201.1ip), and others on the cusp are Mark Buehrle (191.0), Javier Vazquez (188.1), Roy Oswalt (176.1) and Andy Pettitte (178.1)...Arroyo will lead the Reds in starts for the fourth straight season and in innings pitched for the third time in 4 years.

**Quality**: Leads the pitching staff with 19 quality starts...produced QS in each of his last 9 apps (**2-3, 2.19**, 65.2ip, 16er), the longest streak of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a team-best string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

As Luck Would Have It....: Went 9-8, 5.38 in 18 starts before the All-Star break...in the second half is 3-4 in 11 starts despite a sterling 2.42era.

<u>Workhorse</u>: Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 132 starts and leads the National League with 841.1 innings pitched.
