Welcome Back

Former Reds **3B Aaron Boone** will be available to the media today in the Astros' dugout at a time to be determined....**Boone** originally was selected by Cin in the third round of the June 1994 free-agent draft and from 1997-2003 appeared in 668g for the Reds (.271, 86hr, 362rbi, 83sb)...on 3/26 he had open heart surgery at Stanford University Medical Center to repair a valve in his heart that threatened the aorta...on 8/10 **Boone** began an 11-game rehabilitation assignment and on 9/1 was reinstated from the Astros' 60-day disabled list.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Sally Gunter's** Astros and **Game 1** of a 7-game homestand that includes a long weekend 4-game set vs the **Marlins**...are coming off a **4-6 road trip** that included a **3-0 sweep** at Atl's **Turner Field**, an **0-4 visit** to Col's **Coors Field** and a **1-2 stop** at Chi's **Wrigley Field**...was the Reds' first sweep in Atlanta since **7/16-7/18, 2007** and their first ever 4-game sweep loss to the Rockies...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with **13g at Great American Ball Park** (3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit) and **6g on the road** (3g at Pit, 3g at Hou).

HAL MCCOY: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...from **4:30 to 5:30 p.m. on Wednesday**, he will sign autographs at the **Reds Hall of Fame and Museum** and then at **6:30** will be honored in a ceremony on the field at Great American Ball Park...autographs are free with admission to the hall...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

DOT, DOT, DOT: The Reds enter tonight's game with a 4-game winning streak at **Great American Ball Park**, tied for their longest home winning streak of the season (5/24-5/27)...Reds baserunners have been successful on each of their last 5 stolen base attempts...at **53-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings...will be eliminated from National League Wild Card contention with any combination of Reds losses or **Rockies** wins totaling **2**.

PLAYIN' EVERY DAY: Tonight's game is **Game 11** (4-6) in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi, **3g vs Hou**, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **next Monday**, when they will travel to Pittsburgh to begin their final road trip of the season.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **110 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, **110-72**...allowed first-inning runs in 54 of their 143g this season.

STAFF EXPANSION: Class AA Carolina manager **David Bell** temporarily has joined **Dusty Baker's** coaching staff...on 9/22, Class AAA Louisville manager **Rick Sweet** will join the staff in relief of **Bell**.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **118 different lineups** in 143g.

SURGERIES: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: When he plays **IF/OF Juan Francisco** will become the eighth Reds player this season to make his Major League debut, joining **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum**, **OF Drew Stubbs** and **LHP Pedro Viola**..RHP Johnny Cueto, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piecoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfors**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (31-37 .456): The Reds' current 4-game home winning streak ties their season high (5/24-5/27)...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 4-0 vs Pit), including their first 4-game home sweep of the **Pirates** since **August 1975**...went **6-13-3 in their 22 home series**...produced a winning record on 3 of their 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **272-282-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (33-42, .440): The Reds went **4-6** on their most recent road trip (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi)...went **10-12-2 in their previous 24 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their 11 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3, 4-2**, 4-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (161): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 68, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...on 9/10 and 9/11 faced a season-high **20.5-game deficit**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **82** days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 405-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 7-3 this season...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 19-32-1, including 4-2 this season...their 3-game sweep in May was Cin's first here since September 2000...the Reds' 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped their 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...**Lance Berkman's** 21 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Albert Pujols** 2nd, 15)...among opposing pitchers, **Roy Oswalt's** 7 victories here are second only to the 8 wins by Chi's **Carlos Zambrano**.

Wins Beginning 6/29/08

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 23 wins, tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues since then:

CC Sabathia 28-9, 2.79

Roy Halladay 26-14, 2.81

Cliff Lee 24-13, 2.98

Iron Man

Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season, **Bronson Arroyo** ranks among the Major League leaders in games started and innings pitched:

Last Pitched: Wed at Col and received no decision in the dramatic 4-3 loss (7ip, 5h, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 100 pitches, 65 strikes)...left trailing, 2-0, but the Reds tied it in the top of the eighth inning...in the third allowed a sac fly to Smith and a 2-out, RBI-single to Atkins...while he was in the game, Reds batters produced 1 hit off Rockies starter Jason Hammel...Col won it on Smith's 2-out, 2-run single in the bottom of the ninth inning off Cordero.

Red Hots: Is making his 30th start of the season...posted a **1.99era** in August, a **2.42era** since the All-Star break and a **2.17era** in his last 12 starts (87ip, 21er)...pitched into the seventh inning in each of his last 9 starts...his 23 wins beginning 6/29/08 are tied for fourth-most in the Major Leagues (see box to the left)...in his previous 29 starts the Reds went 13-16 and scored 108 runs (3.72 r/g).

Milestones: Enters tonight's game with **29 starts** and **190.0 innings pitched**...produced at least 30 starts and 200 innings in each of the previous 4

seasons...is looking to become one of only a handful of pitchers to record at least 200 innings in each of the last 5 seasons...**Dan Haren** already reached that plateau (201.1ip), and others on the cusp are **Mark Buehrle** (198.0), **Javier Vazquez** (197.1), **Andy Pettitte** (178.1) and **Roy Oswalt** (176.1)...**Arroyo** will lead the Reds in starts for the fourth straight season and in innings pitched for the third time in 4 years.

Workhorse: Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 132 starts and leads the National League with 841.1 innings pitched.

Quality: Leads the pitching staff with 19 quality starts...produced QS in each of his last 9 apps (**2-3, 2.19**, 65.2ip, 16er), the longest streak of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a team-best string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

As Luck Would Have It....: Went **9-8, 5.38** in 18 starts before the All-Star break...in the second half is **3-4** in 11 starts despite a sterling **2.42era**.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 12 of his 29 starts...has posted an 7.14era in the first inning (29ip, 23er) and a 3.63era after the first frame (161ip, 65er).

Last Pitched: Thu at Col and suffered the 5-1 loss (5ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 76 pitches, 47 strikes)...left trailing, 5-1...with 2 outs in the fifth inning allowed 5 runs on a walk and 4 hits, including a 2-run HR by Atkins...the rally began on Young's bunt single back to Wells.

Red Hots: Media guide bio is in the press box...tomorrow will make his eighth appearance and fifth start for the Reds...his appearance on 8/26 at Mil was his first Major League start since 7/21/08, snapping a string of 66 consecutive relief apps for the Rockies, Royals, Nationals and Reds...in his 4 starts the Reds went 3-1 and scored 12 runs (3 r/g).
