Last night **Brandon Phillips** hit his 20th home run of the season to go along with his 26 doubles and 24 stolen bases...**Phillips** and Fla's **Hanley Ramirez** are the only players in the Major Leagues to produce at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 steals in each of the last 3 seasons...see note under **Red Hots**...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Sally Gunter's** Astros and **Game 2** (1-0) of a 7-game homestand that also includes a long weekend 4-game set vs the **Marlins**...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with **12g at Great American Ball Park** (2g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit) and **6g on the road** (3g at Pit, 3g at Hou).

HAL MCCOY: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...**tomorrow**, from **4:30 to 5:30 p.m.** he will sign autographs at the **Reds Hall of Fame and Museum** and then at **6:30** will be honored in a ceremony on the field at Great American Ball Park...autographs are free with a paid admission to the HOF...admission tomorrow is just \$2 for fans using the pass phrase "FOX Sports Ohio"...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Reds.

DOT, DOT, DOT: **RHP Ramon Ramirez** tomorrow will celebrate his 27th birthday...the Reds enter tonight's game with a 5-game winning streak at **Great American Ball Park**, their longest of the season...at **54-0** the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings...will be eliminated from National League Wild Card contention with any combination of Reds losses or **Rockies** wins totaling **2**.

PLAYIN' EVERY DAY: Tonight's game is **Game 12** (5-6) in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi, **1-0 vs Hou**, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **Monday**, when they will travel to Pittsburgh to begin their final road trip of the season.

ROSTER NOTES: Forty-six players have appeared in at least 1 game for the Reds (25 position players, 21 pitchers)...8 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum**, **OF Drew Stubbs**, **LHP Pedro Viola** and **IF/OF Juan Francisco**...19 players made their Reds debuts, including the 8 who made Major League debuts along with **OF Wladimir Balentien**, **1B Kevin Barker**, **OF Jonny Gomes**, **C Ramon Hernandez**, **OF Darnell McDonald**, **OF Laynce Nix**, **3B Scott Rolen**, **CF Willy Taveras**, **RHP Justin Lehr**, **LHP Arthur Rhodes** and **RHP Kip Wells**.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **110 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, **110-72**...allowed first-inning runs in 54 of their 144g this season.

STAFF EXPANSION: Class AA Carolina manager **David Bell** temporarily has joined **Dusty Baker's** coaching staff...on 9/22, Class AAA Louisville manager **Rick Sweet** will join the staff in relief of **Bell**.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **118 different lineups** in 144g.

SURGERIES: **Seven** Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piccoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfes**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (32-37 .464): The Reds' current 5-game home winning streak is a season high...are **1-0** on this homestand (1-0 vs Hou, 4g vs Fla)...went **6-13-3 in their previous 22 home series**...produced a winning record on 3 of their previous 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **273-282-1**...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008).

REDS ON THE ROAD (33-42, .440): The Reds went **4-6** on their most recent road trip (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi)...went **10-12-2 in their 24 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their 11 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3, 4-2**, 4-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (162): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 68, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g over .500** at **36-24**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...on 9/10 and 9/11 faced a season-high **20.5-game deficit**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **83** days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 406-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 8-3 this season...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...at Great American Ball Park: Reds are 20-32-1, including 5-2 this season...their 3-game sweep in May was Cin's first here since September 2000...the Reds' 3-0 win on 4/29 snapped their 11-game losing streak here vs Hou...**Lance Berkman's** 21 homers at GABP are the most by any Reds opponent (**Albert Pujols** 2nd, 15)...among opposing pitchers, **Roy Oswalt's** 7 victories here are second only to the 8 wins by Chi's **Carlos Zambrano**. last Reds sweep: at Cin: 9/22, 1992 (2g, DH); 5/25-5/27, 2009 (3g); 5/21-5/24, 2004 (4g)...at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g).

Last Pitched: Thu at Col and suffered the 5-1 loss (5ip, 6h, 5er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 76 pitches, 47 strikes)...left trailing, 5-1...with 2 outs in the fifth inning allowed 5 runs on a walk and 4 hits, including a 2-run HR by Atkins...the rally began on Young's bunt single back to Wells.

Red Hots: Media guide bio is in the press box...is making his eighth appearance and fifth start for the Reds...his appearance on 8/26 at Mil was his first Major League start since 7/21/08, snapping a string of 66 consecutive relief apps for the Rockies, Royals, Nationals and Reds...in his 4 starts the Reds went 3-1 and scored 12 runs (3 r/g).

2009 Season: Was signed by the Nationals during spring training...began the season at Class AAA Syracuse and was promoted on 4/20 after posting a 2.45era in 2 starts...from 5/31-6/14 was on Wsh's disabled list with a strained right shoulder...was released on 7/6 and the next day was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract...was assigned to Class AAA Louisville and posted a 3.07 in 1 start and 4 relief apps before he was promoted on 7/31, along with RHP Justin Lehr, when the Reds traded IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. to the Yankees and 3B Edwin Encarnacion and RHP Josh Roenicke to the Blue Jays...made his Reds debut on 8/10 at StL after Cueto left in the second inning with an injury.

Wells' Most Recent Starts: 8/26 at Mil, in his first start since 7/21/08 received no decision in the 10-inning, 4-3 victory (5ip, 7h, 3er, 3bb, 2k, 2hr, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 55 strikes)...left trailing, 3-2, but the Reds tied it in the eighth inning and won it in the 10th...allowed all 3 runs on a pair of home runs in the fifth inning, a solo HR to Gerut with 1 out and a 2-out, 2-run HR to Fielder..**8/31 vs Pit**, in the opener of the day/night doubleheader was the victim of a blown save in the 4-3 victory (6ip, 2h, 2er, 4bb, 2k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 3-2, but the Bucs tied it with a run in the seventh inning off Fisher...allowed both runs in the second on RBI-singles to Jaramillo and McCutchen..**9/5 at Atl** and allowed just 1 hit in 6.0 shutout innings to earn the 3-1 victory (4bb, 4k, 1hbp, 97 pitches, 51 strikes)...left leading, 3-0....was his first victory since 4/17/08 for Col at SD, snapping a 6-game losing streak...allowed only Anderson's single leading off the second inning....stranded 6 baserunners.

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Justin Lehr

Last Pitched: Fri at Chi, in his first start since 9/1 suffered the 6-4 loss (4.2ip, 5h, 5er, 3bb, 1k, 1hr, 1hbp, 1wp, 81 pitches, 47 strikes)...left trailing, 5-4...allowed Soto's sac fly in the second inning, a 2-run single to Ramirez with 2 outs in the third and a solo HR to Soto in the fourth...after Gomes' 3-run HR in the top of the fifth tied the game at 4-4, allowed an RBI-single to Ramirez with 2 outs in the bottom of the inning.

Red Hots: Last name is pronounced **LEER**...media guide bio is available in the press box...tomorrow will make his ninth career start, all this season, and his second appearance since skipping a start with a sore right groin...was scheduled to start on 9/7 at Col but was scratched with the injury...in August led the staff in wins (3)...in his 8 starts the Reds went 4-4 and scored 41 runs (5.13 r/g)...has 3 quality apps in 6 starts and fell 3 outs shy of producing another...on **7/31 vs Col** made his first Major League appearance since **5/22/06 for Mil** at Cin and his first career big league start...on **8/5 vs Chi** earned his first career victory since **5/18/06 vs Phi** (5-4 Brewers win).

Most Valuable Pitcher: Was named the International League's **Most Valuable Pitcher**...at Leigh Valley (Phillies) and Louisville combined to finish **13-3, 3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps.

2009 Season: In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 7/31 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by **RHP Micah Owings**, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went **13-3, 3.31** in 18 starts and 2 relief apps.
