**G-20 Summit**  
During the Reds' upcoming series vs the Pirates at PNC Park, the City of Pittsburgh will prepare to host the 2-day **G-20 Summit** that begins there on Thursday...**President Obama** will chair this meeting of leaders from countries around the world that represent 85 percent of the world's economy...the leaders will review the progress made since the Washington and London Summits and will discuss further actions to assure a sound and sustainable recovery from the global financial and economic crisis...the **Group of Twenty** (G-20) formally was established in 1999 to bring together major industrialized and developing economies to discuss key issues in the global economy.

**TODAY'S GAME:** Is **Game 4** (1-2) of a 4-game series vs **Marty Sewell's** Marlins and **Game 7** (4-2) of a 7-game homestand that included a 3-game sweep of the **Astros**...including today's game the Reds will finish the season with **7g at Great American Ball Park** (1g vs Fla, 3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit) and **6g on the road** (3g at Pit, 3g at Hou)...tomorrow the Reds will fly to Pittsburgh, where on Tue they will begin their final road trip of the season (3g at Pit, 3 at Hou).

**DOT, DOT, DOT:** The Reds have played 5 consecutive 1-run games...**Reds relievers** haven't allowed an earned run on this homestand (15.1ip, 4r, 1bb, 16k)...today's **weather is threatening**, but both teams have an off day tomorrow...this afternoon **Aaron Harang** is hosting **30 fans** in sun deck Section 143 as part of his **Aaron's Aces** program targeting local **military families**...on Friday, Class AAA Louisville's **Rick Sweet**, the International League Manager of the Year for the second straight season, will join the Major League coaching staff to finish the season.

**PLAYIN' EVERY DAY:** Today's game is **Game 17** (8-8) in a stretch during which the Reds will have played **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 vs Hou, **1-2 vs Fla**)...tomorrow's **off/travel day** is their first since **8/3**.

**MILESTONES:** **Joey Votto** is trying to become the first Reds batter to hit .300 since **Sean Casey** (.312) and **Ken Griffey Jr.** (.301) did it in **2005**...**RHP Francisco Cordero** is trying to become the first Reds pitcher to lead the National League in saves since **RHP Jeff Shaw** produced 42 saves in **1997**.

**LEADING OFF:** The Reds have **3 leadoff home runs** in their last 5g, including 2 by **Drew Stubbs** (Tue off Hou's **Roy Oswalt**, Sat off Fla's **Ricky Nolasco**) and another by **Darnell McDonald** in his only start of the season batting first (Thu off Fla's **Anibal Sanchez**)...**Stubbs** leads the club with 3 leadoff HR (other, 8/31 off Pit's **Daniel McCutchen**), the most by a Reds batter since **Ryan Freel** produced 3 leadoff homers in **2006**.

**HAL MCCOY:** Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...on 9/16 he was honored in a pregame ceremony at Great American Ball Park...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

**ROSTER NOTES:** Forty-six players have appeared in at least 1 game for the Reds (25 position players, 21 pitchers)...8 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum**, **OF Drew Stubbs**, **LHP Pedro Viola** and **IF/OF Juan Francisco**...19 players made their Reds debuts, including the 8 who made Major League debuts along with **OF Wladimir Balentine**, **1B Kevin Barker**, **OF Jonny Gomes**, **C Ramon Hernandez**, **OF Darnell McDonald**, **OF Laynce Nix**, **3B Scott Rolen**, **CF Willy Taveras**, **RHP Justin Lehr**, **LHP Arthur Rhodes** and **RHP Kip Wells**.

**FIRST WATCH:** The Reds have allowed **113 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, **113-78**...allowed first-inning runs in 55 of their 149g this season.

**OPENING DAY LINEUP:** Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **121 different lineups** in 149g.

**SURGERIES:** **Seven** Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

**REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (35-39 .473):** Fri's 4-3 loss to Fla snapped the Reds' 8-game home winning streak, their season high and 1 shy of the ballpark record...are **4-2** on this homestand (3-0 vs Hou, 1-2 vs Fla)...went **7-13-3 in their previous 23 home series**...including this homestand produced a winning record on 4 of their 12 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2, 4-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **276-284-1**.

**REDS ON THE ROAD (33-42 .440):** The Reds went **4-6** on their most recent road trip (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi)...went **10-12-2 in their 22 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their 11 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3, 4-2, 4-6**)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

**IN THE STANDINGS (167):** The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 73, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...on 9/10 and 9/11 faced season-high **20.5-game deficits**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **88** days below .500.

**REDS vs MARLINS:** The Reds are 79-61 all-time vs the Marlins, including 2-3 this season and 8-5 the last 2 seasons...lost the last 2g but have won 11 of their last 16g vs Fla...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds are 12-10, including 1-2 this season and 8-2 the last 3 seasons...lost the last 2g but have won 9 of the last 11g here vs Fla.

**UP NEXT: REDS vs PIRATES:** The Reds are **976-1,020 all-time** vs the Pirates, including **8-4 this season**...**at PNC Park:** Reds are 34-33 all-time, including **3-3 this season**.

**Last Pitched:** Tue vs Hou, threw a season-high 6.2 innings but received no decision in the 5-4 victory (5h, 4er, 2bb, 1k, 1hr, 98 pitches, 62 strikes)...left with the score tied, 4-4...threw 28 pitches in the top of the first inning, when the Astros scored 3 times on 3 hits, a walk and 3 stolen bases...allowed just 1 run and 2 hits the rest of his outing...from the third through the seventh innings retired 13 consecutive batters.

**Red Hots:** Media guide bio is available in the press box...is making his ninth appearance and sixth start for the Reds...**went 1-1, 4.40 in his 5 starts (28.2ip, 14er) and 0-1, 4.15 in his 3 relief apps (8.2ip, 4er)**...in his 5 starts the Reds went 4-1 and scored 17 runs (3.40 r/g)...his appearance on 8/26 at Mil was his first Major League start since 7/21/08, snapping a string of 66 consecutive relief apps for the Rockies, Royals, Nationals and Reds.

**2009 Season:** Was signed by the Nationals during spring training...began the season at Class AAA Syracuse and was promoted on 4/20 after posting a 2.45era in 2 starts...from 5/31-6/14 was on Wsh's disabled list with a strained right shoulder...was released on 7/6 and the next day was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract...was assigned to Class AAA Louisville and posted a 3.07 in 1 start and 4 relief apps before he was promoted on 7/31, along with RHP Justin Lehr, when the Reds traded IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. to the Yankees and 3B Edwin Encarnacion and RHP Josh Roenicke to the Blue Jays...made his Reds debut on 8/10 at StL after Cueto left in the second inning with an injury.

Tuesday at Pirates: RHP Johnny Cueto

**Last Pitched:** On 9/12 at Chi and was a victim of a blown save in the 7-5 victory (5.1ip, 4h, 3er, 3bb, 3k, 86 pitches, 54 strikes)...left leading, 5-2, but was charged with 1 run scored off Herrera...Cubs tied it in the seventh on Soto's 2-run double off Masset...after Theriot's infield single in the first inning didn't allow another hit until Lee's bloop single in the sixth.

**Red Hots:** The 23-year-old righthander on Tue at Pit will make his 28th start of the season, his fourth since a stint on the disabled list with inflammation in his right shoulder...was on the DL from **8/20-8/31**...in 3 starts since then is **1-0, 2.76** (16.1ip, 5er)...**missed Thu's scheduled start vs Fla with the flu**...leads the Major Leagues in hit batsmen (14, tied w/ Mil's Dave Bush) and 3 times hit 2 batters in a game...in his 27 starts the Reds went 14-13 and scored 107 runs (3.96 r/g)...in 9 of his 27 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 17 of his 27 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

**Streaking:** The 6-3 win on 8/31 vs Pit snapped his career-high 6-game losing streak...through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...**in his next 8 starts, from 7/6-8/15, went 0-6, 10.64**...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went **4-0, 1.25**...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since **Tim Belcher** had a 4-game run from **5/27-6/13, 1992** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

**World Baseball Classic:** Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
