This season Nineteen players made 21 apps on the Reds' disabled list...the 19 disabled players is the club's highest total since 2003, when 19 players were disabled 25 times...7 Reds players currently are on the DL.

G-20 Summi

The City of Pittsburgh is preparing to host the 2-day **G-20 Summit** that begins here Thursday...**President Obama** will chair this meeting of leaders from countries around the world that represent 85 percent of the world's economy...the leaders will review the progress made since the Washington and London Summits and will discuss further actions to assure a sound and sustainable recovery from the global financial and economic crisis...the **Group of Twenty** (G-20) formally was established in 1999 to bring together major industrialized and developing economies to discuss key issues in the global economy.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Greg Johnson's** Pirates and **Game 1** of the Reds' final road trip of the season (**3g at Pit**, 3g at Hou)...are coming off a **5-2 homestand** vs the **Astros** (3-0) and **Marlins** (2-2)...following this road trip the Reds will finish the 2009 season with 6g at **Great American Ball Park** (3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit).

DOT, DOT: Third base coach **Mark Berry** today is celebrating his **47th** birthday...**Reds relievers** didn't allow an earned run on the 7-game homestand completed Sunday (17.1ip, 4r, 1bb, 17k)...Friday in Houston, Class AAA Louisville's **Rick Sweet**, the International League Manager of the Year for the second straight season, will join the Major League coaching staff to finish the season.

<u>PLAYIN' EVERY DAY</u>: On Sunday the Reds completed a stretch in which they played **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season...went **9-8** during that stretch (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi, 3-0 vs Hou, 2-2 vs Fla)...yesterday's **off day** was their first since **8/3**.

<u>MILESTONES</u>: Joey Votto is trying to become the first Reds batter to hit .300 since **Sean Casey** (.312) and **Ken Griffey Jr.** (.301) did it in **2005**...**RHP Francisco Cordero** is trying to become the first Reds pitcher to lead the National League in saves since **RHP Jeff Shaw** produced 42 saves in **1997**.

LEADING OFF: The Reds have **3 leadoff home runs** in their last 6g, including 2 by **Drew Stubbs** (Tue off Hou's **Roy Oswalt**, Sat off Fla's **Ricky Nolasco**) and another by **Darnell McDonald** in his only start of the season batting first (Thu off Fla's **Anibal Sanchez**)...**Stubbs** leads the club with 3 leadoff HR (other, 8/31 off Pit's **Daniel McCutchen**), the most by a Reds batter in a season since **Ryan Freel** produced 3 leadoff homers in **2006**...no Reds batter has produced more than 3 leadoff homers in a season since **Jerome Walton** had **4** in **1995** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

<u>HAL McCoy</u>: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...on 9/16 he was honored in a pregame ceremony at Great American Ball Park...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

ROSTER NOTES: Forty-six players have appeared in at least 1 game for the Reds (25 position players, 21 pitchers)...8 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum, OF Drew Stubbs, LHP Pedro Viola and IF/OF Juan Francisco...19 players made their Reds debuts, including the 8 who made Major League debuts along with OF Wladimir Balentien, 1B Kevin Barker, OF Jonny Gomes, C Ramon Hernandez, OF Darnell McDonald, OF Laynce Nix, 3B Scott Rolen, CF Willy Taveras, RHP Justin Lehr, LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP Kip Wells.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 113 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, 113-78...allowed first-inning runs in 55 of their 150g this season.

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr**. (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **122 different lineups** in 150g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C** Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (36-39 .480): The Reds have won 9 of their last 11 home games... went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (3-0 vs Hou, 2-2 vs Fla)...went 7-13-4 in their 24 home series...produced a winning record on 4 of their 12 homestands, including each of their last 2 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, 5-2, 5-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 277-284-1...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (33-42, .440): The Reds went 4-6 on their previous road trip (3-0 at Atl, 0-4 at Col, 1-2 at Chi)... went 10-12-2 in their previous 24 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their 11 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3, 4-2, 4-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (169): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 75, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 51-71 were a season-high 20g under .500...on 9/10 and 9/11 faced season-high 20.5-game deficits...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 90 days below .500.

REDS vs PIRATES: The Reds are 976-1,020 all-time vs the Pirates, including 8-4 this season...<u>at Great American Ball Park</u>: Reds are 30-29 all-time, including 5-1 this season...<u>at PNC Park</u>: Reds are 34-33 all-time, including 3-3 this season...<u>last Reds sweep</u>: at Pit: 8/3-8/4, 2007 (2g); 8/26-8/28, 2005 (3g); 7/2-7/5, 1992 (4g)...<u>last Pirates sweep</u>: at Pit: 8/20-8/21, 1998 (2g); 4/11-4/13, 2008 (3g); 8/22-8/24, 1969 (4g).

Last Pitched: On 9/12 at Chi and was a victim of a blown save in the 7-5 victory (5.1ip, 4h, 3er, 3bb, 3k, 86 pitches, 54 strikes)...left leading, 5-2, but was charged with 1 run scored off Herrera...Cubs tied it in the seventh on Soto's 2-run double off Masset...after Theriot's infield single in the first inning didn't allow another hit until Lee's bloop single in the sixth...missed his next scheduled start with the flu.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander is making his 28th start of the season, his fourth since a stint on the disabled list with inflammation in his right shoulder...was on the DL from 8/20-8/31...in 3 starts since then is 1-0, 2.76 (16.1ip, 5er)...missed Thu's scheduled start vs Fla with the flu...leads the Major Leagues in hit batsmen (14, tied with Mil's Dave Bush) and 3 times hit 2 batters in a game...in his 27 starts the Reds went 14-13 and scored 107 runs (3.96 r/g)...in 9 of his 27 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 17 of his 27 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Streaking: The 6-3 win on 8/31 vs Pit snapped his career-high 6-game losing streak...through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...in his next 8 starts, from 7/6-8/15, went 0-6, 10.64...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25... the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Quality: Has 13 quality starts...put together 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14).

<u>World Baseball Classic</u>: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).

Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Homer Bailey

<u>Last Pitched</u>: Fri vs Fla, threw 7.0 shutout innings and tied his career high with 8 strikeouts but was the victim of a blown save in the 4-3 loss (3h, 2bb, 117 pitches, 76 strikes)...left leading, 2-0, but the Marlins scored 4 unearned runs in the top of the ninth off Cordero and Burton...the Reds lost for the first time all season when leading after 8 innings...had been 57-0.

Red Hots: Tomorrow will make his 18th start of the season, the 35th start of his Major League career and his third start of the season vs the Pirates...in his last 6 starts is 3-1, 1.83 and twice was the victim of blown saves...in his 17 starts the Reds went 6-11 and scored 74 runs (4.35 r/g).

2009 Season: Began the year at Class AAA Louisville, where he went 3-5, 4.57 with 2 complete games and a shutout in 8 starts before he was promoted on 5/22...started the 7-6 loss vs Cle on 5/23, then was optioned back to Louisville the next day...made 6 more starts for the Bats (5-0, 0.81) before he was recalled again to start on 6/27 at Cle.

At Louisville: In 14 apps for the Bats produced 11 quality starts, including quality starts in each of his last 7 apps (5-1, 1.07, 50.1ip, 47h, 6er, 12bb, 45k)...in his first start of the season allowed a season-high 8 earned runs in 5.1 innings (13.50era) and in his last 13 starts posted a 2.03era (84.1ip, 19er)...following his last start for the Bats ranked among the International League leaders in innings pitched (89.2, 1st), wins (8, 2nd), strikeouts (82, 2nd) and ERA (2.71, 10th)...for the Bats, in 6 starts between his 5/22 and 6/27 promotions went 5-0, 0.81.
