Climbing the Standings

For the fourth straight day the Reds are in fourth place in the National League Central Division...is Cin's highest spot in the standings since **7/10** (4th, -4.5)...from 7/11 until Tuesday the Redlegs spent 73 consecutive days in fifth (72 days) or sixth place (1 day, 8/22)...the Reds trail third-place Mil by 3.0g and lead the fifth-place Astros by 1.5g.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**: Is **Game 2** (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Aaron Boone's** Astros and **Game 5** (4-0) of the Reds' final road trip of the season (3-0 at Pit, **1-0 at Hou**)...beginning Tuesday, the Redlegs will finish the 2009 championship season with 6g at **Great American Ball Park** (3g vs StL, 3g vs Pit).

**RED FIVE**: During the Reds' current 5-game winning streak **Joey Votto** is 11-for-22 (7 2b, 2hr, 10rbi, 9r), including a stretch Tue and Wed at Pit in which he reached base in 8 straight plate apps that raised his BA from .304 to .315 (5 doubles, 2 singles, 1 walk)...**Votto** leads all Major Leaguers in hitting beginning 9/10 (25-56, .446)...**Reds batters** during the winning streak are hitting .346 (65-188), including .406 with RISP (28-69), with 16 doubles and 44 runs scored...**Reds pitchers** during the winning streak have posted a 2.40era (45ip, 12er).

<u>DOT, DOT.</u> During batting practice tonight Reds manager **Dusty Baker** will speak to about 30 kids from **Carl Crawford Youth Sports, Inc.**..Baker is a sponsor of the non-profit group...the Redlegs have won 5 straight games, 9 of their last 11g and 22 of their last 32g...have won the last 8g vs the Astros and 16 of their last 18g overall vs **NL Central opponents**...**Reds starting pitchers** in the last 7g have posted a **2.11era** (47ip, 11er)...**Reds relievers** in the last 11g have posted a **1.27era** (28.1ip, 4er)...the Reds have just 4 errors in their last 17g.

MILESTONES: Brandon Phillips (95rbi) is trying to become only the second Reds second baseman ever to produce 100rbi in a season (Joe Morgan, 110rbi as a 2B in 1976)...Joey Votto (.315) is trying to become the first Reds batter to hit .300 since Sean Casey (.312) and Ken Griffey Jr. (.301) did it in 2005...RHP Francisco Cordero (39sv, 2nd in NL) is trying to become the first Reds pitcher to lead the National League in saves since RHP Jeff Shaw produced 42 saves in 1997...Bronson Arroyo is 9 strikeouts shy of 1,000 for his career.

ROSTER MATTERS: The 2 Reds players eligible for free agency following this season are RHP Kip Wells and C Ramon Hernandez (team option for 2010)...the 3 Reds players eligible for arbitration are OF Jonny Gomes, C Corky Miller and OF Laynce Nix...potentially eligible for arbitration as Super 2s are RHP Jared Burton, RHP Nick Masset and RHP Micah Owings.

**LEADING OFF**: The Reds have **3 leadoff home runs** in their last 10g, including 2 by **Drew Stubbs** (9/15 off Hou's **Roy Oswalt**, Sat off Fla's **Ricky Nolasco**) and another by **Darnell McDonald** in his only start of the season batting first (9/17 off Fla's **Anibal Sanchez**)...**Stubbs** leads the club with 3 leadoff HR (other, 8/31 off Pit's **Daniel McCutchen**), the most by a Reds batter in a season since **Ryan Freel** produced 3 leadoff homers in **2006**...no Reds batter has produced more than 3 leadoff homers in a season since **Jerome Walton** had **4** in **1995** (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Roster Notes: Forty-six players have appeared in at least 1 game for the Reds (25 position players, 21 pitchers)...8 Reds players made their Major League debuts, including RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum, OF Drew Stubbs, LHP Pedro Viola and IF/OF Juan Francisco...19 players made their Reds debuts, including the 8 who made Major League debuts along with OF Wladimir Balentien, 1B Kevin Barker, OF Jonny Gomes, C Ramon Hernandez, OF Darnell McDonald, OF Laynce Nix, 3B Scott Rolen, CF Willy Taveras, RHP Justin Lehr, LHP Arthur Rhodes and RHP Kip Wells.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 114 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues, and have been outscored in the opening frame, 114-80...allowed first-inning runs in 56 of their 154g this season.

<u>OPENING DAY LINEUP</u>: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **124 different lineups** in 154g.

<u>SURGERIES</u>: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including C Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), SS Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement), C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), IF Danny Richar (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), RHP Edinson Volquez (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and RHP Aaron Harang (appendectomy).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (36-39 .480): The Reds have won 9 of their last 11 home games...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (3-0 vs Hou, 2-2 vs Fla)...went 7-13-4 in their 24 home series...produced a winning record on 4 of their 12 homestands, including each of their last 2 homestands (2-3, 2-4, 3-2, 6-3, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, 5-2, 5-2)...in 7 seasons at GABP are 277-284-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (37-42, .468): The Reds are 4-0 on this road trip (3-0 at Pit, 1-0 at Hou)...went 11-12-2 in their previous 25 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 11 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3, 4-2, 4-6)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (173): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 39, FIFTH - 75, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 51-71 were a season-high 20g under .500...on 9/10 and 9/11 faced season-high 20.5-game deficits...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 94 days below .500.

REDS vs ASTROS: The Reds are 409-382-1 all-time vs the Astros, including 11-3 this season...have won the last 8g vs Hou...the Reds' 4-2 win at Minute Maid Park on 4/19/09 was their 400th victory vs Hou...at Minute Maid Park: Reds are 31-47, including 4-1 this season...last Reds sweep: at Cin: 9/22, 1992 (2g, DH); 9/14-9/16, 2009 (3g); 5/21-5/24, 2004 (4g)...at Hou: 9/14-9/15, 1981 (2g); 6/2-6/4, 2006 (3g); 6/24-6/27, 1999 (4g).

**Last Pitched:** On 9/16 vs Hou, tied the club record by allowing 5 home runs but received no decision in the 6-5 win (5ip, 11h, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 99 pitches, 67 strikes)...left trailing, 5-4, but the Reds scored a run in the sixth and another in the seventh...allowed solo HR to Matsui, Lee, Keppinger (2) and Blum...tied his career high with 11 hits allowed.

Red Hots: Last name is pronounced LEER...media guide bio is avavailable in the press box...is making his 10th career start, all this season, and his third appearance since skipping a start with a sore right groin...was scheduled to start on 9/7 at Col but was scratched with the injury...in his 2 starts since then is 0-1, 9.31 (9.2ip, 10er)...in August led the staff in wins (3)...in his 9 starts the Reds went 5-4 and scored 47 runs (5.22 r/g)... has 3 quality starts and fell 3 outs shy of producing another...on 7/31 vs Col made his first Major League appearance since 5/22/06 for Mil at Cin and his first career big league start...on 8/5 vs Chi earned his first career victory since 5/18/06 vs Phi (5-4 Brewers win)...on 8/11 at StL singled off Mitchell Boggs for his first Major League hit.

<u>Most Valuable Pitcher</u>: Was named the International League's <u>Most Valuable Pitcher</u>...at Leigh Valley (Phillies) and Louisville combined to finish 13-3, 3.31 in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...tied for the International League lead in victories and ranked fourth in ERA...3 times was IL Pitcher of the week...was the starting pitcher for the IL in the <u>Triple-A All-Star Game</u> in Portland.

Shutout: In his 4-0 victory on 8/5 vs the Cubs threw a complete-game shutout in just his second Major League start (4h, 1bb, 4k)...became the first Reds pitcher to throw a shutout in his first or second career start since Charlie Leibrandt beat the Braves, 5-0, in his big league debut on 4/13/80 and the first pitcher to do it for any team since the Red Sox' Clay Buchholz threw a no-hitter on 9/1/07 vs Bal in his second career start... courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

Scattering Hits: In his 5-4 victory on 8/11 at StL, earned the decision after allowing 11 hits, all singles, and 1 run in 6+ innings...according to Elias Sports Bureau, became just the third pitcher since 1900 to earn a win while allowing zero or 1 run and at least 11 hits in 6.0 innings pitched or less...the other 2 were Cle's Jack Kralick in 1965 (6ip, 11h, 1r) and Bal's Pat Rapp in 2000 (6ip, 11h, 1r).

2009 Season: In December was signed by the Phillies to a minor league contract and began the season with Class AAA Lehigh Valley (8g, 7gs, 5-2, 4.75)...on 5/22 was traded to the Reds in exchange for cash...went 8-1, 2.51 in 11 starts and 1 relief appearance at Class AAA Louisville before he was promoted on 7/31 to take the spot in the rotation vacated by RHP Micah Owings, who went on the disabled list with a tight right shoulder...overall at Class AAA went 13-3, 3.31 in 18 starts and 2 relief apps...when promoted, his 13 victories tied for the most among all minor league pitchers...3 times was International League Pitcher of the Week, including twice for Lehigh Valley in the first 5 weeks of the season and from 7/20-7/26 for Louisville (2gs, 2-0, 1.88)...was IL's starting pitcher in the Triple-A All-Star Game in Portland.

## Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

**Last Pitched**: Tue at Pit, in his first appearance since 9/12 earned the 10-4 victory (5ip, 9h, 2er, 0bb, 2k, 1hr, 101 pitches, 68 strikes)... left leading, 5-2...allowed a leadoff HR to McCutchen and an RBI-double by Cedeno in the fourth inning...missed his previous start with a throat infection.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 29th start of the season, his fifth since a stint on the disabled list with inflammation in his right shoulder...was on the DL from 8/20-8/31... in 4 starts since then is 2-0, 2.95 (21.1ip, 7er)...missed a scheduled start on 9/17 vs Fla with a throat infection...leads the Major Leagues in hit batsmen (14, tied with Mil's Dave Bush) and 3 times hit 2 batters in a game...in his 28 starts the Reds went 15-13 and scored 117 runs (4.18 r/g)...in 9 of his 28 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 17 of his 28 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

<u>Streaking</u>: The 6-3 win on 8/31 vs Pit snapped his career-high 6-game losing streak...through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69 and made a strong bid for a spot on the National League All-Star team... in his next 8 starts, from 7/6-8/15, went 0-6, 10.64 until he went on the DL...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career....

Quality: Has 13 quality starts...put together 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14).

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
