TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Lee Wilson's Braves** and **Game 1** of a 10-game road trip that includes upcoming visits to Col's **Coors Field** (4g) and the friendly confines of Chi's **Wrigley Field** (3g)...will be the Reds' first 4-game series in **Denver** since **April 1998** and the third of their 3 scheduled trips to **Chicago**...tonight's game is **Game 1** in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (**3g at Atl**, 4g at Col, 3g at Chi, 3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **Mon, 9/21**...the Reds are coming off a **4-2** homestand vs **LAD** (1-2) and **Pit** (3-0) that included their first 4-game home sweep of the **Pirates** since **August 1975**...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 13g at **Great American Ball Park** and 16g on the road.

REHAB WATCH: **OF Jay Bruce** (broken right wrist) and **C Ryan Hanigan** (concussion) last night made their rehab debuts with Louisville...in the 4-2 Bats win at Indianapolis, **Bruce** played RF and went 0-for-3, while **Hanigan** caught and went 1-for-3...**Bruce** has been eligible to come off the DL since 7/27, **Hanigan** will be eligible Wednesday.

DOT, DOT, DOT: The Redlegs are **6-10** after a day off...**have won 4 straight games and 9 of their last 11g**...despite 9 win in their last 11g the Reds have gained just half a game in the standings during that span...their current 4-game winning streak is 1 shy of their season high (8/23-8/28)...their 4 current-game *road* winning streak ties their season high (5/5-5/13)...**CF Drew Stubbs** has **4 homers in 70 at bats** for the Reds after hitting **3 homers in 411 at bats** for Louisville...at **51-0** the Reds club is the NL's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed **109 first inning runs**, the most in the Major Leagues and have been outscored in the opening frame, **109-71**...allowed first-inning runs in 53 of their 133g this season.

STAFF EXPANSION: Reds minor league field coordinator **Freddie Benavides** has joined manager **Dusty Baker's** coaching staff...on 9/14, **Benavides** will be replaced by Class AA Carolina manager **David Bell**...on 9/22, Class AAA Louisville manager **Rick Sweet** will join the staff in relief of **Bell**.

HAL MCCOY: Reds beat writer **Hal McCoy** of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on **Wed, 9/16**...**McCoy** has worked for the *DDN* for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is **McCoy's** 37th covering the Redlegs.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just **10g** (5-5) that included the projected **2009 Opening Day** lineup of **C Ramon Hernandez**, **1B Joey Votto**, **2B Brandon Phillips**, **3B Edwin Encarnacion** (traded) **SS Alex Gonzalez** (traded), **RF Jay Bruce**, **CF Willy Taveras** and either **Chris Dickerson** or **Jerry Hairston Jr.** (traded) in LF...Reds manager **Dusty Baker** has produced **110 different lineups** in 133g.

SURGERIES: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including **C Ramon Hernandez** (cleaned out left knee), **SS Alex Gonzalez** (removed loose bodies, right elbow), **RHP Mike Lincoln** (cervical disc replacement), **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **IF Danny Richar** (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), **RHP Edinson Volquez** (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and **RHP Aaron Harang** (appendectomy).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: When he pitches **LHP Pedro Viola** will become the seventh Reds player this season to make his Major League debut, joining **RHP Carlos Fisher**, **LHP Matt Maloney**, **IF Drew Sutton**, **RHP Robert Manuel**, **C Craig Tatum** and **OF Drew Stubbs**...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: **RHP Johnny Cueto**, **IF Paul Janish**, **OF Jay Bruce**, **LHP Daniel Ray Herrera**, **RHP Daryl Thompson**, **IF Adam Rosales**, **OF Chris Dickerson**, **RHP Ramon Ramirez**, **C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo** and **RHP Josh Roenicke**.

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder **FOX Sports Ohio** has won an **Emmy Award** for its *Reds Live* pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts **Jim Day** and **Jeff Piecoro**, producer **Kent Weaver** and directors **Brian Hunterman** and **Roy Alfes**...FOX Sports Ohio also won an **Emmy** for its **Columbus Blue Jackets** NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (31-37 .456): The Reds' current 4-game home winning streak ties their season high (5/24-5/27)...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 4-0 vs Pit) and **6-13-3 in their 22 home series**...produced a winning record on 3 of their 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2, 6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **272-282-1**...from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)...last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at **217-217-1** the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since **6/26/04** (57-57)...also reached .500 at **219-219-1**.

REDS ON THE ROAD (29-36, .446): The Reds' current 4-game road winning streak ties their longest of the season (5/5-5/13)...went 4-2 on their most recent road trip (1-2 at Pit, 3-0 at Mil)...went **9-10-2 in their 21 road series**...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (**7-3, 3-2, 3-3**, 2-5, 2-4, **3-3**, 2-5, 0-6, **3-3, 4-2**)...entering this season and dating to 2006, **the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips**.

IN THE STANDINGS (151): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 58, SIXTH - 2...at **20-14** and **26-20** were a season-high **6g over .500**...prior to this season hadn't been **6g over .500** since **2006**, when they reached a season-high **12g** over .500 at **36-24**...at **51-71** were a season-high **20g under .500**...on **8/30** were a season-high **19.5 games out of first place**...have spent **64** days above, **15** days at and **72** days below .500.

REDS vs BRAVES: The Reds are 1,072-964 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 3-3 this season...**at Great American Ball Park:** Reds went 17-12, including 3-3 this season...won 9 of the last 12g vs the Braves at GABP...**at Turner Field:** Reds are 16-28, including 0-3 in 2008...the Braves' 3-game sweep from 5/2-5/4 of last season was their first of the Reds in Atl since 8/23-8/25, 1999...**last Reds sweep:** at Cin: 9/28-9/29, 1987 (2g); 5/30-6/1, 2008 (3g); 4/9-4/13, 1980 (4g)...at Atl: 4/15-4/16, 1986 (2g); 7/16-7/18, 2007 (3g); 4/13-4/16, 1990 (4g)...**last Braves sweep:** at Cin: 7/18-7/19, 2001 (2g); 9/15-9/17, 1995 (3g); 5/31-6/3, 1984 (5g)...at Atl: 9/9-9/10, 1992 (2g); 5/2-5/4, 2008 (3g).

Wins Beginning 6/29/08

In the 14-1 loss on 6/24/08 at Tor, **Bronson Arroyo** made the shortest start of his career and became only the sixth starting pitcher in Major League history to allow at least 10 earned runs in a game in which he retired 3 batters or fewer (1+ip, 11h, 10er)...beginning with his next start, a 9-5 win at Cle on 6/29/08, **Arroyo** has 22 wins, tied for fifth-most in the Major Leagues since then:

Last Pitched: Sun vs LAD and received no decision in the 12-inning, 3-2 loss (7.1ip, 6h, 2er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr, 103 pitches, 69 strikes)...left with the score tied, 2-2...didn't allow a hit until Kemp homered...leading off the fifth inning...later in that frame allowed an RBI-single to Kershaw...Reds batters produced 20 strikeouts.

Red Hots: Is making his 28th start of the season...posted a **1.99era** in 6 starts in August...his 22 wins beginning 6/29/08 are tied for fifth-most in the Major Leagues...in his 27 starts the Reds went 12-15 and scored 102 runs (3.78 r/g).

Quality: Leads the pitching staff with 17 quality starts...produced QS in each of his last 7 apps (**1-3, 2.26**, 51.2ip, 13er), the longest streak of quality starts by a Reds pitcher this season...last year, **Edinson Volquez** produced a team-best string of 12 straight QS (4/22-6/20).

As Luck Would Have It....: Went **9-8**, **5.38** in 18 starts before the All-Star break...in the second half is **2-4** in 9 starts despite a sterling **2.53era**.

Zeroes: From 8/8-8/19 put together a 17.0-inning scoreless streak, the longest by a Reds pitcher this season and tying his career high (7/2-7/19, 2004).

Workhorse: Since he was acquired by the Reds prior to the 2006 season leads all Major League pitchers with 130 starts and leads the National League with 827.1 innings pitched.

In The Big Inning: Allowed at least 1 run in the first inning of 12 of his 27 starts...has posted an 7.67era in the first inning (27ip, 23er) and a 3.74era after the first frame (149ip, 62er).
