**Brandon Phillips** has hit safely in 4 straight games (10-15, .667, 2hr, 6rbi), including two 2-hit games and two 3-hit games, and in 11-13g (22-54, .407, 2hr, 10rbi)...he leads all National League second basemen with 85rbi and 23 stolen bases...according to Elias Sports Bureau, his .571 batting average (16-28) over the last 8g is the highest of any player in the Major Leagues with at least 20ab over that span....Pit's Lastings Milledge is second at .542 (13-24).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs Alex Ritchey's Braves and Game 2 (1-0) of a 10-game road trip that includes upcoming visits to Col's Coors Field (4g) and the friendly confines of Chi's Wrigley Field (3g)...will be the Reds' first 4-game series in Denver since April 1998 and the third of their 3 scheduled trips to Chicago...tonight's game is **Game 2** (1-0) in a stretch during which the Reds will play **17 consecutive days**, their longest uninterrupted stretch of the season (**1-0 at Atl**, 4g at Col, 3g at Chi, 3g vs Hou, 4g vs Fla)...their next day off is **Mon**, **9/21**...including tonight's game the Reds will finish the season with 13g at Great American Ball Park and 15g on the road.

REHAB WATCH: OF Jay Bruce (broken right wrist) and C Ryan Hanigan (concussion) last night made their second rehab apps with Louisville and participated in the longest game in the history of Indianapolis' Victory Field...in the Bats' 16-inning, 4-2 win Bruce played RF and went 0-for-3 with a walk and a run scored, while Hanigan caught and went 1-for-4 with a double and a run scored...Bruce (2g, 0-6, 1bb, 1r on rehab) has been eligible to come off the DL since 7/27, Hanigan (2g, 2-7, 1 2b, 1r on rehab) will be eligible Wednesday.

DOT, DOT, DOT: The Redlegs are 0-8 on Saturdays since their 5-2 win at StL on 5/4...with 773 career apps LHP Arthur Rhodes ranks 48th on that all-time list...Don Sutton is 47th with 774 apps...at 52-0 the Reds club is the National League's only undefeated team when leading after 8 innings.

FIRST WATCH: The Reds have allowed 109 first inning runs, the most in the Major Leagues and have been outscored in the opening frame, 109-71...allowed first-inning runs in 53 of their 134g this season.

STAFF EXPANSION: Reds minor league field coordinator Freddie Benavides has joined manager Dusty Baker's coaching staff...on 9/14, Benavides will be replaced by Class AA Carolina manager David Bell...on 9/22, Class AAA Louisville manager Rick Sweet will join the staff in relief of Bell.

<u>HAL McCOY</u>: Reds beat writer Hal McCoy of the *Dayton Daily News* will retire following this season...he will be honored in a pregame ceremony on Wed, 9/16...McCoy has worked for the DDN for 46 years and is enshrined in the writers' wing of the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown...the longest-tenured baseball beat writer in the country, the 2009 campaign is McCoy's 37th covering the Redlegs.

OPENING DAY LINEUP: Because of injuries and trades, the Reds will finish the season with just 10g (5-5) that included the projected 2009 Opening Day lineup of C Ramon Hernandez, 1B Joey Votto, 2B Brandon Phillips, 3B Edwin Encarnacion (traded) SS Alex Gonzalez (traded), RF Jay Bruce, CF Willy Taveras and either Chris Dickerson or Jerry Hairston Jr. (traded) in LF...Reds manager Dusty Baker has produced 111 different lineups in 134g.

SURGERIES: Seven Reds players have had surgical procedures this season, including C Ramon Hernandez (cleaned out left knee), SS Alex Gonzalez (removed loose bodies, right elbow), RHP Mike Lincoln (cervical disc replacement), C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), IF Danny Richar (repaired torn labrum, left shoulder), RHP Edinson Volquez (repaired torn ulnar collateral ligament and torn flexor mass, right elbow) and RHP Aaron Harang (appendectomy).

MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: When he pitches LHP Pedro Viola (pronounced vee-OLA) will become the seventh Reds player this season to make his Major League debut, joining RHP Carlos Fisher, LHP Matt Maloney, IF Drew Sutton, RHP Robert Manuel, C Craig Tatum and OF Drew Stubbs...in 2008, 10 Reds players made their Major League debuts: RHP Johnny Cueto, IF Paul Janish, OF Jay Bruce, LHP Daniel Ray Herrera, RHP Daryl Thompson, IF Adam Rosales, OF Chris Dickerson, RHP Ramon Ramirez, C/IF/OF Wilkin Castillo and RHP Josh Roenicke.

EMMY AWARD: For the second consecutive year, Reds TV rightsholder FOX Sports Ohio has won an Emmy Award for its Reds Live pre-game show (sports programs category)...congratulations to hosts Jim Day and Jeff Piecoro, producer Kent Weaver and directors Brian Hunterman and Roy Alfers...FOX Sports Ohio also won an Emmy for its Columbus Blue Jackets NHL game coverage (live sporting event category).

REDS AT GREAT AMERICAN BALL PARK (31-37 .456): The Reds' current 4-game home winning streak ties their season high (5/24-5/27)...went 5-2 on their most recent homestand (1-2 vs LAD, 4-0 vs Pit), including their first 4-game home sweep of the Pirates since August 1975...went 6-13-3 in their 22 home series...produced a winning record on 3 of their 11 homestands (2-3, 2-4, **3-2**, **6-3**, 1-2, 3-3, 3-3, 2-2, 2-8, 2-5, **5-2**)...in 7 seasons at GABP are **272-282-1**... from 7/28-8/4 lost 8 straight home games, tying the ballpark record for consecutive home losses (8/5-8/16, 2008)... last season established the ballpark record for victories in a season (43-38)...at 217-217-1 the Reds had evened their overall record at GABP for the first time since 6/26/04 (57-57)...also reached .500 at 219-219-1.

REDS ON THE ROAD (30-36, .455): The Reds' current 5-game road winning streak is their longest of the season... are 1-0 on this road trip (1-0 at Atl, 4g at Col, 3g at Chi)...went 9-10-2 in their previous 21 road series...produced a winning or .500 record on 6 of their previous 10 road trips (7-3, 3-2, 3-3, 2-5, 2-4, 3-3, 2-5, 0-6, 3-3, 4-2)...entering this season and dating to 2006, the Reds had losing records in 23 of their previous 28 road trips.

IN THE STANDINGS (152): The Reds have spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the National League Central Division standings: FIRST - 1, SECOND - 9, THIRD - 46, FOURTH - 35, FIFTH - 59, SIXTH - 2...at 20-14 and 26-20 were a season-high 6g over .500...prior to this season hadn't been 6g over .500 since 2006, when they reached a season-high 12g over .500 at 36-24...at 51-71 were a season-high 20g under .500...on 8/30 were a season-high 19.5 games out of first place...have spent 64 days above, 15 days at and 73 days below .500.

REDS vs BRAVES: The Reds are 1,073-964 all-time vs the Braves franchise, including 4-3 this season...at Turner Field: Reds are 17-28, including 1-0 this season...<u>last Reds sweep</u>: at Cin: 9/28-9/29, 1987 (2g); 5/30-6/1, 2008 (3g); 4/9-4/13, 1980 (4g)...at Atl: 4/15-4/16, 1986 (2g); 7/16-7/18, 2007 (3g); 4/13-4/16, 1990 (4g).

Last Pitched: Mon vs Pit, in the opener of the day/night doubleheader was the victim of a blown save in the 4-3 victory (6ip, 2h, 2er, 4bb, 2k, 1hbp, 108 pitches, 60 strikes)...left leading, 3-2, but the Bucs tied it with a run in the seventh inning off Fisher...allowed both runs in the second on RBI-singles to Jaramillo and McCutchen.

Red Hots: Media guide bio is in the press box...is making his sixth appearance and third start for the Reds...his appearance on 8/26 at Mil was his first Major League start since 7/21/08, snapping a string of 66 consecutive relief apps for the Rockies, Royals, Nationals and Reds...in his 2 starts the Reds went 2-0 and scored 8 runs (4 r/g).

2009 Season: Was signed by the Nationals during spring training...began the season at Class AAA Syracuse and was promoted on 4/20 after posting a 2.45era in 2 starts...from 5/31-6/14 was on Wsh's disabled list with a strained right shoulder...was released on 7/6 and the next day was signed by the Reds to a minor league contract...was assigned to Class AAA Louisville and posted a 3.07 in 1 start and 4 relief apps before he was promoted on 7/31, along with RHP Justin Lehr, when the Reds traded IF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr. to the Yankees and 3B Edwin Encarnacion and RHP Josh Roenicke to the Blue Jays...made his Reds debut on 8/10 at StL after Cueto left in the second inning with an injury.

# Tomorrow's Pitcher: RHP Johnny Cueto

Last Pitched: Mon vs Pit, in the nightcap of the day/night doubleheader and his first appearance after a stint on the disabled list earned the 6-3 victory to snap his career-high 6-game losing streak (5+ip, 3h, 1er, 1bb, 5k, 1hr, 85 pitches, 56 strikes)...left leading, 4-1...allowed only a sixth-inning leadoff HR to McCutchen, his final batter.

Red Hots: The 23-year-old righthander tomorrow will make his 26th start of the season, his second since a stint on the disabled list with inflammation in his right shoulder, and his first career appearance at Turner Field...was on the DL from 8/20-8/31...in his 25 starts the Reds went 12-13 and scored 96 runs (3.84 r/g)...in 9 of his 25 starts threw at least 7.0 innings and in 16 of his 25 starts threw at least 6.0 innings.

Streaking: Mon's 6-3 win vs Pit snapped his career-high 6-game losing streak...through 16 starts on 7/1 was 8-4, 2.69...in his next 8 starts, from 7/6-8/15, went 0-6, 10.64...in 5 starts from 4/22-5/13 went 4-0, 1.25...the 4-game winning streak was the longest of his career...in each of 4 starts from 4/22-5/8 threw at least 7.0 innings while allowing no more than 1 run, the longest streak of that kind by a Reds pitcher since Tim Belcher had a 4-game run from 5/27-6/13, 1992 (courtesy Elias Sports Bureau).

Quality: Has 12 quality starts but none in his last 6 apps...put together 2 strings of 5 consecutive QS (4/22-5/13, 5/24-6/14),

World Baseball Classic: Started the Dominican Republic's second game of the tournament and threw 4.2 scoreless innings to earn the 9-0 win vs Panama in the San Juan bracket (4.2ip, 3h, 1bb, 5k).
