In the last 15 seasons of his career, 9 times was the top-rated shortstop in the league in Elias Sports Bureau's rankings.

Finished his 19-year career with a batting average of .295 in 2,180 games...hit at least .300 nine times.

Is the only shortstop in Major League history with at least 2,300 hits, 190 home runs and 370 stolen bases.

Is one of only 17 players ever to appear in at least 2,000 games at shortstop.

Was successful on **83 percent** of his stolen bases attempts (379-456), the **fourth-highest** mark since caught stealing information has been compiled (1951) and the **best rate** among all players from 1986-2004 whose primary position was shortstop.

Played all 19 of his Major League seasons with the Reds...was team captain from 1997 through his final season in 2004.

In 1996 became the first shortstop in Major League history to produce 30 homers and 30 steals in the same season.

Is 1 of only 7 NL shortstops with 30 homers in a season...holds the Reds' single-season record for HR by a SS (33, 1996).

Hit .300 from 1989-93 to become the first shortstop in 40 years to hit at least .300 in 5 straight seasons.

Won the Roberto Clemente Award in 1993 and the Lou Gehrig Memorial Award in 1994.

According to baseball historian Bill James is "one of the 10 most complete players in history" and the sixth-greatest shortstop ever behind Hall of Famers Honus Wagner, Arky Vaughan, Cal Ripken Jr., Robin Yount and Ernie Banks and just ahead of Ozzie Smith...is included in Bill Deane's book *The Top Ten Baseball Shortstops of All-Time.*
