Rule 5 Draft, scheduled for December 10 during the Winter Meetings in Indianapolis...any player eligible for the Rule 5 Draft who is not protected on a Major League 40-man roster may be selected by another team...eligibility for the draft depends on the player's age during the signing season of his first contract...generally, players who sign at age 19 or older are under a club's control for 4 seasons, while players who sign at age 18 or younger are under a club's control for 5 seasons...after Friday's deadline, no team can promote a minor league player to its 40-man roster until after the Rule 5 Draft, though it can remove a player from the roster to make room for a Rule 5 draft selection.
